Questions You May Have

When do I require a dog license and what are the fees?

All dogs 24 weeks of age or older on the 1st of January require a license.

1. Intact Males & Non-Spayed Females
\$30.00
2. Spayed Females, Neutered Males
\$10.00
3. Dogs that have just reached the age of 24 weeks the fee is prorated to a minimum of \$5.00.

Does my dog need to wear the license?

Yes, the dog must wear the license on its collar or harness at all times [unless kept in a pen or enclosure on the owner's property]. The tag allows the Animal Control Officer to contact you.

What should I do if I lose my license?

A replacement tag is available for \$2.00 at all license locations.

Should I have my dog on a leash?

Yes. All dogs must be on a leash and/or under the control of a competent person when off their owner's property.

When a dog defecates is the owner required to remove the feces?

Yes. Owners are required to promptly remove and dispose of the feces in a sanitary manner [Cawston area exempt].

What if my dog or other animal [cat or horse] has been impounded by the Poundkeeper?

Your dog, cat, or horse will be released after payment of impoundment and maintenance fees. Dogs, cats, or horses not claimed within 72 hours may be destroyed, sold or adopted.

Can a dog be deemed Dangerous?

Yes. The Poundkeeper may deem a dog dangerous if he has killed, injured, aggressively pursued or harassed any person, dog, bird, or animal.

Are there fines if someone violates this Bylaw?

Fines up to \$2,000 can be imposed on any person who violates any portion of the Bylaw.



How many dogs or other animals can I have on my property?

Electoral Areas B - Cawston, and G – Rural Keremeos/Hedley your bylaw limits you to no more than 3 dogs, 10 rabbits, or 5 cats over the age of 24 weeks, on property less than 1.2 acres in size. Restrictions could apply to other District area - please call 1-877-610-3737.

Impoundment and Maintenance Fees

Impoundment Fees—Dogs (other than Dangerous Dogs) and Animals in a Calendar Year

- 1st impoundment \$50.00
- 2nd impoundment \$100.00
- 3rd impoundment \$250.00
- Additional impoundments \$500.00

Impoundment Fee Dangerous Dogs

- Each impoundment \$1000.00

Maintenance Fees

- Each 24 hour period \$10.00
