EVACUATION ALERTS RESCINDED for properties along Highway 97 near Okanagan Lake Provincial Park in Electoral Area “F”

The RDOS advises that the threat of wildfire has been reduced and the potential danger to life, health and property has diminished in certain areas. An Evacuation Alert, pursuant to the Emergency Programs Act, issued for the properties along Highway 97 near Okanagan Lake Provincial Park north of Summerland has been **RESCINDED**.
