EVACUATION ORDER for Nine Properties in Twin Lakes is RESCINDED

The threat of flooding in the vicinity of Twin Lakes; in Electoral Area “D”, has been reduced. The potential danger to life, health and property damage has declined. The Evacuation Order, pursuant to the Emergency Program Act, issued on May 25, 2018, to the below listed property has been **RESCINDED** as follows.
