**Re: Scheduled Events during the Naramata Water System Rehabilitation Project Construction**

In March 2017, the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) received a BC Clean Water/Wastewater Fund (CWWF) grant from the Federal and Provincial governments to help fund a replacement project of approximately 5km of underground watermains in Naramata. The CWWF grant requires that all design and construction work be completed prior to March 31, 2018. In order to meet the granting requirements, the construction timeline is very short and all replacements will be completed before December of this year.

Ecora Engineering & Resource Group Ltd. (Ecora) has completed the design for replacing these high priority watermains. The following pages provides maps of the six areas anticipated to undergo construction. On April 21<sup>st</sup>, 2017 the RDOS released the invitation to tender for the construction of this project.

In order to minimize the effect of construction on your business, the RDOS is requesting that a representative from your business contact the RDOS by May 10, 2017 with any major events or activities that you have scheduled which could be impacted by the construction. The RDOS will work with Ecora and the construction contractor to determine a schedule with the least disruption possible. Due to the size of this project and the tight time frame, the RDOS cannot guarantee that every event and activity notification we receive can be accommodated, but we will work to minimize any negative impacts. As construction moves into your area, notifications will be distributed with any planned disruption from the Contractor.

The RDOS understands that this is a large undertaking and construction can be an inconvenience to everyone within the community. The RDOS is working with the Naramata residents and businesses to minimize any disruptions. The RDOS would like to thank you in advance for your cooperation, patience and understanding during the rehabilitation of your water system.

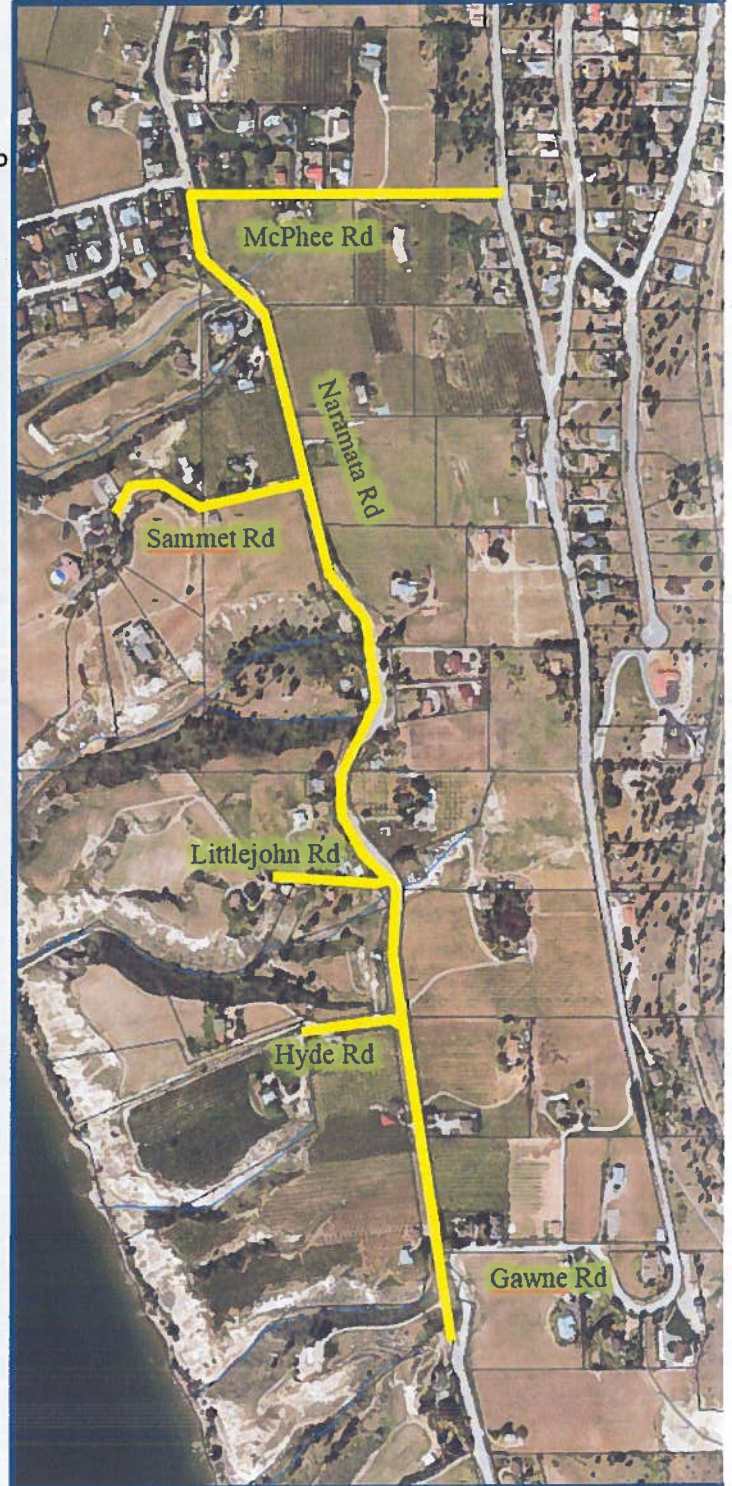


## General Maps of the Six Areas of Rehabilitation
