CURBSIDE GARBAGE COLLECTION - WEEKLY

- Collections every Wednesday starting 7 am
- **Never place garbage out overnight unless in Bear resistant bin or enclosure**
- Contact RDOS for 'Bear Aware' information
- 2 - Container (bag or can) weekly limit
- **Max weight:** 25 kg (55 lbs) for any bag/can
- **Max volume:** 95L per bag/can
- If you have **more than two containers**, place 'Tag-a-Bag' stickers on extra bags as needed.
- RDOS 'Tag-a-bag' stickers can be purchased at Campbell Mountain Landfill, RDOS Main Office for **\$1.50** each

PRINTED PAPER AND PACKAGING COLLECTION - ALTERNATING WEEKS

Unlimited residential recycling every two weeks as indicated on calendar.

- Use clear or clear blue plastic bags or a clearly marked reusable container or cart.
- Max weight individual bag/can: 25 kg (55 lbs)
- Clean acceptable materials can go in same bag
- **WET PAPER CONTAINERS** – paper cups, milk cartons, tetra-paks, ice cream, frozen juice containers. Please clean!
- **PLASTIC CONTAINERS (NO Styrofoam or Bags)** plastic bottles, jugs, containers. Caps also recyclable but keep separate. Please clean!
- **METAL CONTAINERS** – empty aerosol cans, clean cans, trays. Labels and lids OK. Return beverage containers for deposit. Please clean!
- **MIXED PAPER** and **BOXBOARD** – paper, phone books, envelopes, catalogues, paper bags, cereal, pizza boxes, magazines.
- Flatten **LARGE CARDBOARD BOXES** and cut pieces to no larger than 30" (78 cm) wide or tall; bundle with tape or twine.



DO NOT PLACE IN HOME RECYCLING!

- **NO** food waste, food residue or liquids
- **NO** electronics or batteries (recycle at depot)
- **NO** clothing or textiles (donate if good condition)
- **NO** Styrofoam or Plastic Bags (recycle at depot)
- **NO** hard or soft cover books (recycle at landfill)
- **NO** glass (recycle at depot)
- **NO** reusable plastic containers ie. Tupperware
- **NO** plastic oil or pesticide containers (recycling facilities exist – ask RDOS for locations)

RECYCLING AT DROP OFF DEPOTS

Free recycling depots at **Campbell Mtn Landfill** or **J&C Bottle Depot** 200 Rosetown Ave Penticton during operating hours. Depots will accept **clean and separated**:

- Glass containers (jars, bottles)
- White and Coloured Styrofoam Packaging (no chips or insulation)
- Plastic bags and wrap from containers
- Keep your **Metal, Plastic and Wet Paper Containers** separate from **Paper and Cardboard** at all depots!



YARD WASTE PICKUP – ALTERNATING WEEKS

During indicated Yard Waste collection weeks place out an unlimited amount of yard waste in the following types of containers by 7:00 am:

- Clearly marked garbage can, paper yard waste bags or yard waste cart,
- Max weight: 25 kg (55 lbs) for any bag/can,
- "Yard Waste Only" stickers available to place on cans as reminder, contact Regional District,
- Bundle sticks - using string or twine (3' max length, 3" max branch diameter).

NO plastic bags, garbage, food scraps, rocks, sod, stumps, pots / trays, construction material or animal droppings.

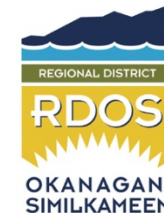

LARGE ITEMS COLLECTION - ONCE PER YEAR

On **April 18th, 2018** max 2 items per household:

- Common items include furniture, fridges, freezers, large appliances and mattresses.
- **Max weight:** 90 kg / 200 lbs per item.
- **NO** renovation waste including toilets, hot water tanks, carpet, heat pumps, furnaces, plumbing and doors.
- Please take electronics and small appliances to (TVs, computers, etc) to the Campbell Mtn. Landfill or J & C Bottle Depot at 200 Rosetown Ave, Penticton for free recycling.

No garbage containing food waste allowed

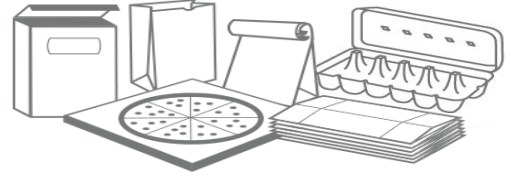
Curbside Recycling Collection Put In What Works!



Printed Paper:

Newspaper, magazines, envelopes,
telephone directories, catalogues

NO books or padded envelopes



Dry Paper Packaging:

Paper bags, boxes, pizza boxes,
non-waxed cardboard

NO tissue paper or paper with foil



Coated Paper Packaging:

Paper cups, milk cartons, tetra-paks,
ice cream boxes

NO straws. Please rinse.



Metal Packaging:

Cans, metal lids, pie plates, foil wrap,
juice concentrate/'Pringles' cans,
empty aerosol cans. **Please clean.**



Plastic Packaging:

Bottles, trays, tubs, non-Styrofoam take
away food containers. Lids/caps can be
removed and recycled with containers.

No Styrofoam or plastic bags

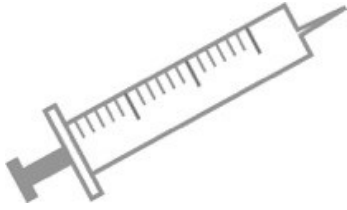

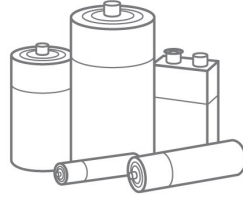
Curbside Recycling Collection

Keep Out What Hurts!



Needles/Medical Waste

Speak to your local pharmacy for disposal options.



Batteries

Starts fires! Easy to recycle at dozens of businesses and at landfills.



Pressurized Tanks

Both flammable and helium tanks explode! Recycle at landfills.



Food and Drink Waste

Unclean packaging can attract pests and make people sick.



Electronics/Appliances

Not accepted. Recycle at local bottle depots and landfills.



Plastic Items

Only recycle food grade packaging! All other plastics go in garbage!



Container Glass

Recycle at Depot Only

Cuts workers.
Contaminates materials.



Plastic Film Bags/Overwrap

Recycle at Depot Only

Wraps equipment.
Contaminates materials.



Polystyrene (Styrofoam)

Recycle at Depot Only

Breaks apart.
Contaminates materials
