Transit Transfers for Naramata and Penticton

Effective May 19th, BC Transit customers in Penticton and Naramata can travel through the two transit systems thanks to a new reciprocal transfer policy. Transfers are good for 90 minutes following time of issue. This transfer system will allow seamless service for the customer and will provide better value for their fare.

The City of Penticton and the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen (RDOS) operate the Penticton and Okanagan-Similkameen (Naramata) Transit Systems respectively. The Naramata bus runs from Cherry Lane Mall to Naramata 3 to 5 times per day with stops at Penticton Plaza, Wade and Martin, Johnston Road and Vancouver Avenue.

The pilot program will run on a trial basis for one year after which staff at the RDOS and the City of Penticton will evaluate the program.

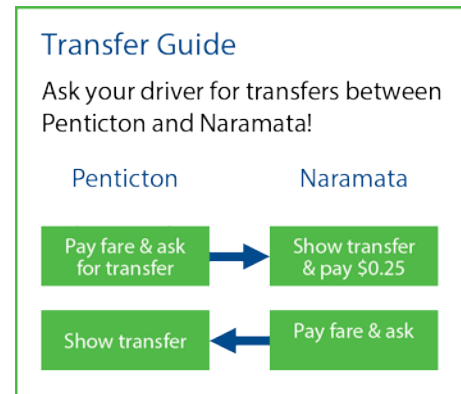
Penticton Customers

When travelling to Naramata, regular fares or passes plus a transfer and a \$.25 top-up are required.

Naramata Customers

When travelling to Penticton, regular fares or passes plus a transfer is all that is required.

* Please note that transfers have also been approved between the City of Penticton and the District of Summerland, however, there are no transfers for transit riders between Summerland and Naramata at this time.
