Updated Sand and Sandbag Locations

Residents who have sandbagged areas on their properties, should leave them in place as a precautionary measure. Any residents that have experienced flooding on their properties or want to be proactive can obtain sand and sandbags at the following locations.

Naramata – There are 4 locations in Naramata

- Sand and sandbags at Naramata Fire Hall on Lower Debeck Rd,
- Sand at Mill Rd, north of 4395 Mill Rd in open area west side of road,
- Sand at Robinson Point cul de sac near 20 Robinson Point,
- Sand at Indian Rock boat launch north of 218 Summer Set Lane.

Town of Osoyoos – Sandbags at the Public works Yards, 11500 115th St, Osoyoos stacked outside the gates for after-hours pick-up. Sand available across the street from the Dairy Queen, on Main St.

Rural Osoyoos – Sand and sandbags available at the corner of 91st Street and Highway 97 at the north end of Osoyoos Lake.

Keremeos, Cawston and area residents – Sand and sandbags available at Village of Keremeos Irrigation Pump Station, 900 Sparks Dr, corner of 1st and Sparks Dr.

Olalla - Sand and sandbags at 2644 7th St.

Town of Oliver - There are 2 locations in Oliver for sand and sandbags

- Public Works Yards, 5971 Sawmill Rd.,
- Oliver Fire Hall, 369 Similkameen Ave.

Willowbrook- Sand and sandbags at Willowbrook Fire Hall, 3395 Willowbrook Rd.

Okanagan Falls – Sand at the end of Cedar Rd, by the old Sewer Plant (by the river) and sandbags at the Fire Hall at 5013 11th Ave.

Vaseaux Lake – Sand and sandbags at 117 Sundial Road.

Summerland - There are 2 locations in Summerland for sand and sandbags

- Fire Hall 10115 Jubilee Rd,
- Summerland Public Works at 9215 Cedar Area.

Faulder (Rural Summerland) – Sand and sandbags at post box pull out, at the junction of Fish Lake Road and the Princeton Summerland Road.

Red Wing Resort Penticton – Sand and sandbags at Club House.

City of Penticton – Sand and sandbags Fire Hall #2 – 285 the corner of Dawson Ave.

Town of Princeton – Sand and sand bags at Princeton Fire Hall, 174 Penryn Ave.

Tulameen – Otter Lake, Otter Creek –Sand and sandbags are available at the Fire hall.
