**ADDENDUM NO. 1

By this Addendum #1, the Request for Proposals Document for the above noted Project shall be clarified.

**1) 6.12 PRODUCT MANAGEMENT**

- a) The Contractor is required to coordinate and schedule the loading of ground materials for transport off-site with the haulers identified by the Regional District.*
  
- b) The Contractor is required to schedule the off-site delivery of materials with the receiving location and determine the accessibility of the location.*

Clarification:

- a) The Regional District has most often utilized the services of Sun-Oka Valley Transport Ltd. (Sun-Oka is the designated hauler for materials taken to the Glenmore Landfill in Kelowna).
  
- b) In 2017, 5,280 m<sup>3</sup> of wood chips were shipped off-site the majority of which went to Kelowna and Keremeos 2,860 m<sup>3</sup> and 1,540 m<sup>3</sup> respectively. In 2018, 17,600 m<sup>3</sup> of wood chips were shipped off-site, 8,910 to Kelowna and 5,280 to Keremeos. To-date sufficient transport truck capacity has been made available during on-site grinding events. All Chips were loaded with a Loader equipped with a Rollout Bucket. The contractor is responsible for the scheduling of off-site shipment and logistics.
  
- c) Proponents are encouraged to include in their Proposal competitive alternate off-site Transport options.
