

Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen

BYLAW NO. 1127

A Bylaw to establish an extended service for the regulation or prohibition of the sale or disposal of firecrackers and fireworks within the boundaries of Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F' of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen.

WHEREAS, a regional district may, by bylaw, establish and operate an extended service under the provisions of Part 24 of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 932 (e) of the Municipal Act, the Board of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen wishes to establish an extended service for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting the sale or disposal of firecrackers and other fireworks of every nature or kind within the boundaries of Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F';

AND WHEREAS the assent of the electors has been waived under Section 800 (1) (b) of the Municipal Act;

AND WHEREAS the Directors of Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F' have consented in writing to the adoption of this bylaw in accordance with Section 800 (2) of the Municipal Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen in open meeting duly assembled enacts as follows:

1. The Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen hereby establishes an extended service for the purpose of regulating or prohibiting the sale and disposal of firecrackers and other fireworks of every nature or kind within Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F'.
2. The sale or disposal to any person of firecrackers and other fireworks of every nature or kind is hereby prohibited within Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F'.
3. The annual operating costs shall be recovered by requisition of monies to be collected by a property value tax in Electoral Areas 'D' and 'F' on the net taxable value of land and improvements taxable for hospital purposes only.

4. No borrowing shall be incurred for the purposes of this extended service.
5. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be deemed to be guilty of an offence against this bylaw liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$500.00 for each offence.
6. This bylaw may be cited as the "Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen Fireworks Prohibition and Regulation Extended Service Bylaw No. 1127, 1990".
