**Purpose of Bylaw:**

The purpose of this amendment bylaw is to amend the Electoral Area “C” Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaws and Electoral Area “D-1” Official Community Plan and Zoning bylaws as they relate to the Dominion Radio Astrophysical Observatory (DRAO) in order to ensure consistence of objectives, policies, regulations and mapping across those Electoral Areas to which DRAOs Radio Frequency Interference (RFI) Area applies.
